   Keeping in mind the goals and objectives of the college IQAC has arranged the following things:
  - **a)** Special classes (Remedial Coaching Classes) are arranged for the academically backward students. Special coaching classes have also been arranged by different Departments for the meritorious students.
- b) In this academic session (2013-2014) all the Departments, being directed by IQAC, have arranged meetings with the guardians of the students who have failed in their Pre-Final Part 1 Test Examination and as per their request supplementary examination has been held. Students, who were unable to secure 40% marks in supplementary test, are not sent up for their Final

University Examination. And this decision has been taken along with the Teachers' Council, Students' Union and Guardian Forum.
