- C. Get your **<u>REGISTRATION ID AND PASSWORD</u>** on your mobile.
- D. Click on "<u>APPLY ONLINE</u>" menu and log in using **REGISTRATION ID and PASSWORD** (to be sent to your mobile no. and keep it for future use) and select Hons & General courses for application.
- E. Modify personal & academic details if necessary and apply in your desired courses.

Step 2: Steps to be followed after publication of Merit List

- a) Final Merit Lists along will be displayed on the College Website on the date notified.
- b) See Online Counseling details.
- c) <u>Candidates selected in allotment list, are required to pay admission fees within</u> <u>stipulated date as mentioned in Important Dates (Hons/General). Otherwise</u> <u>his/her candidature will be cancelled (see detailed instructions for payment of</u> <u>admission fees at the time of publication Allotment list).</u>

Step 3: What to do after payment of admission fees (Date of Activation of link for downloading Registration form will be notified later)

- a) Log in using **APPLICATION ID and PASSWORD** and take print out of your application form and registration form.
- b) Printed Registration Form and Application Form (consisting Photo and signature of the candidate) with other requisite documents are to be submitted in the college office on the stipulated date to get the **Roll No**. with **Fees Book, Temporary Library Card and Identity Card.**
- c) Taking Roll no. on stipulated date is mandatory failing of which the candidature will be cancelled.
- d) Students, already enrolled in another College, should get their Admission cancelled from the previous college, before getting Admission (See Verification for details).

N.B.

a) The admission is provisional, subject to scrutiny and verification of the documents submitted. The provisional admission is liable to be cancelled if the student fails to submit documents required by the University. If admission of any such student is not approved by the University, she/he will not be entitled to any refund of fees.

- b) Selection will be strictly on the basis of merit.
- c) It is assumed that the information furnished in the application is true to the best of the knowledge of the applicant. In case of any false / misleading information, the application will be summarily rejected.
- d) It is also assumed that the applicant is applying voluntarily on his / her own discretion without being influenced by any third party.
- e) The college authority reserves the rights of admission / rejection of any applicant without assigning any reason whatsoever.
- f) In case of fraudulent activities / misconduct, observed even at a later stage, a candidate / student may be debarred from the college at the sole discretion of the College Authority and legal action may be initiated.

- g) <u>50% (maximum) of fees (after admission) will be reimbursed to the person who are efficient in Cultural activities (having a certificate from Govt. Approved Academy) and, Sports activities (having a certificate of participation/medallist in Subdivision /District /State /National / International level)</u>.
- h) <u>25% (maximum) of fees (after admission) will be reimbursed to the person who will participate in NCC and NSS.</u>
- i) <u>Classes for all female students admitted in 1st Year B.A. (General) course will be held in morning shift (from 8.00 A.M. onwards) and classes for all male students admitted in 1st Year B.A. (General) course will be held in the afternoon shift (from 1.00 P.M. onwards) and remaining Honours and General course student should attend class in day shift (10.00 A.M. onwards).

- j) <u>General Candidates who are eligible for General (EWS) category, are required</u> to upload Annexure-C as per West Bengal Govt. Order No.: 325-PAR(AR)/3P-1/2019 dated 09/07/2019.

Eligibility:

For the purpose of determining eligibility for admission to the Honours / General Course, **aggregate marks** shall be calculated by adding the marks in top-four subjects in order of marks secured by a candidate **provided he/she has also passed in English having full marks not being less than 100.** However, marks in compulsory Environmental Education/ Studies (ENVE) shall not be taken into account for calculation of aggregate marks. If the subject "Environmental Science" is studied as an elective subject of 100 marks, it may be taken into account for the purpose of determining the aggregate marks.

Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Vocational examination conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development shall be eligible to seek admission to the B.A. (General) only (without taking Education and Geography as combination subject). Candidates who have passed the Higher Secondary (10+2) Vocational Examination in Business & Commerce conducted by the West Bengal State Council of Technical & Vocational Education and Skill Development shall be eligible to seek admission to the B.Com (General) course of Studies under this University.

The students who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent Examination in 2015, 2016 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020 are eligible for admission.

Pass in a subject means 30% marks in both theory and practical (if applicable).

c) Candidates who willing to take **Computer Science** as combination subject, must pass in **Mathematics**, **Physics and Chemistry** in H.S. (10+2) examination.

d) Candidates who willing to take **Education** as combination subject, must pass in **Education /Psychology /Philosophy /Mathematics /Sociology /Economics /Political Science** /History in H.S. (10+2) examination.

e) The students who were admitted in earlier sessions, but did not enroll for B.A./B.Sc. (Pure & Bio)/B.Com. (Honours /General) Part I/1st or 2nd Semester Examinations up to 2020 or the students who were admitted in earlier sessions and enrolled for B.A./B.Sc. (Pure & Bio)/B.Com. (Honours/General) Part I/1st or 2nd Semester Examinations but did not appear in Part I/1st or 2nd Semester Examinations up to 2020, can apply for readmission, but their merit index will be calculated as per rules notified in Merit Index calculation section.

f) The students who were admitted in earlier sessions and appeared in B.A./B.Sc. (Pure & Bio)/B.Com. (Honours/General) Part I/1st or 2nd Semester Examinations in 2020 or earlier, can't apply for readmission and shall continue to be guided by the existing Regulations of Annual / Semester System.

Merit Index Calculation

For Honours Course

 a) Merit-list of all Honours subjects will be framed on the basis of <u>aggregate percentage of</u> <u>Best Four marks (Except ENVE) + percentage of subject marks opted for Honours</u> obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.

For General Course

- a) Merit-list of all <u>General Course</u> will be framed on the basis of <u>aggregate percentage of</u> <u>Best Four marks (Except ENVE)</u> obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.
- b) Merit List for <u>Computer Science</u> as Core Course subject will be based on <u>aggregate</u> <u>percentage of Best Four marks (Except ENVE) + percentage of marks in Mathematics</u> <u>+ percentage of marks in Physics</u> obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.
- c) Merit List for <u>Geography</u> as Core Course subject will be based on <u>aggregate percentage of</u> <u>Best Four marks (Except ENVE) + percentage of marks in Geography</u> obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.
- d) Merit List for <u>Education</u> as Core Course subject will be based on <u>aggregate percentage of</u> <u>Best Four marks (Except ENVE) + percentage of marks in</u> <u>Education/Psychology/Philosophy/Mathematics/Sociology/Economics/Political Science/</u> <u>History</u> obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.
- e) Merit List for <u>Microbiology</u> as Core Course subject will be based on <u>aggregate percentage</u> of <u>Best Four marks (Except ENVE)</u> + <u>percentage of marks in Biology/ Bio-</u> <u>Technology+percentage of marks in Chemistry/ Physics</u>obtained in the H.S (10+2) or equivalent examination.
 - The students who have passed Higher Secondary or equivalent Examination- 2015, 2016, 2017, 2018, 2019 and 2020 are eligible for admission. But their merit index (i.e. percentage of Best Four marks and opted Honours subject marks (for Honours course) and percentage of Best Four marks (for General Course)) will be reduced @ 10 % for

each preceding year i.e. 10 % marks will be deducted for the candidates who have passed the said examination in the year 2019, 20 % marks will be deducted for the candidates who have passed the said examination in the year 2018 and 30 % for the candidates of 2017 and so on. According to Calcutta University rules, the candidates who have passed the HS or equivalent examination in the year before 2015 are not eligible for admission.

• The Compartmental or C.C candidates are also eligible for admission through online application. But their total marks will be reduced @ 5 % extra for each year of appearance in the said examination.
